

- BLAST Athletics fundraising program is our biggest general fundraiser of the year.
- It allows family and friends to experience who and what they are supporting.
- Students can get creative by sharing photos and videos of their Band or Pageantry experience with their donors, which will keep them involved and engaged throughout the year.
- The user-friendly, safe, and powerful platform allows for both text and email donation requests, including automatic reminders. Requests can be in English or Spanish.
- Last year we raised almost \$50,000, without everyone participating. Imagine the impact it will
  have on our program if all students participate!

### **BLAST Athletics Fundraiser Schedule**

#### **AUGUST 1:**

Our BLAST representative will meet with students during practice to help with sign ups and creating their donation page. A video message from the student group will be posted on the main Tartan Band & Pageantry Blast page.

BETWEEN <u>AUG 1</u> AND <u>AUG 14</u>, STUDENTS WILL COMPLETE A LIST OF 20 POTENTIAL DONORS – NAMES AND PHONE NUMBERS OR EMAIL ADDRESSES. THESE CAN BE FAMILY, FRIENDS, OR NEIGHBORS.

#### **AUGUST 14:**

Students will participate in a **Call-a-thon from 1:30-2:30pm** at the outdoor event center **at Glenkirk Church**. Students will **personally reach out** to each of their potential donors to let them know that they'll soon be **receiving a text or email** asking for their **support of the program**. Scripts will be provided to help students.


#### AUGUST 15 -AUGUST 29:







### Parent Booster Volunteer Needs

#### **Uniforms and Grooming:**

- Help students with uniforms such as attaching sash, tartan, glengarry, belt, etc.
- Provide grooming assistance braiding and pinning hair

#### Chuckwagon:

Provide and coordinate meals, snacks, and drinks to students & staff during marching band season at all competitions (Street and Field).

#### **Seat Covers:**

Place and later remove cloth seat coverings on bleachers in designated sections at home football games, awards and after field competitions.

#### Water Person(s):

Filling water jugs and squeeze bottles with water and ice. Water is needed at street and field competitions, for students when they must stand in place - water is brought to them in squeeze bottles. At football games, water is needed at the practice field area, the track where Guard rehearses, and in the stands. During competitions, water Is needed at base camp, and for parades, pulled behind the Band in one or more carts.

#### Truck Driver(s):

Brings instruments and equipment to performances, requires a volunteer form and an additional truck driver form clearance from GUSD. Generally, requires ownership of a truck, submission of driver's license and proof of insurance, and experience pulling a box trailer. Use of their own truck would be used to pull box trailers.

#### Street Practice Volunteers:

- For parade street practices near GHS, volunteers are needed to help monitor the intersections and hold flags and traffic signs to guide vehicles to detours around the band practice.
- Volunteers needed to set up and monitor plastic street barricades at intersections so students can practice on the street for parade competitions. This requires at least one person with an SUV or truck that can load and unload the plastic barricades.


