

Field Tournament Protocols

- Spectators must be seated in the Spectator Seating area
- Cheering is WELCOMED AND ENCOURAGED!!
 - No horns or noise makers of any kind are allowed
- Parent Volunteers
 - Helping with props and equipment only as needed and determined by staff
 - Must have a wrist band
 - Will help with equipment and props when entering/exiting the stadium field area only
 - May not touch instruments or any equipment during the performance, for any reason
 - May not go onto the field should sit on designated bleachers or stand against the wall, out of the way of judges

Band Review (Street Performance) Protocols

- Spectators must stay on the sidewalk you cannot be on the street
- Parent Volunteers
 - Assignments will be coordinated prior to the event
 - Volunteers designated to walk with the Band & Pageantry will be provided instructions
 prior to each Band Review about where to walk during the Band Review performance –
 must stay out of the street throughout the entire competition zone
 - For Street, do not cheer loudly until the bagpipes have finished and the band begins to play otherwise the Band and Guard cannot hear whistles and drums





Parent Booster Volunteers

Throughout the school year, there will be many opportunities to volunteer for the GHS Band & Pageantry program. As a Parent Booster, we encourage you to register with the Glendora Unified School District. Registering does not mean that you will need to volunteer for every event/activity, but you do need to register if you want to volunteer.

Below are the volunteer level descriptions and requirements for each level.



SCAN the QR Code to complete the GUSD Volunteer Application online **LEVEL 1:** Event/Activity Volunteers (infrequent/not prolonged student interaction)

Examples of LEVEL 1 Volunteer support: Helping with street practice
and passing out water to students
(football games, competitions,
parades, and street practice).

- a. Completed volunteer application each school year
- Provide a copy of your current
 California Driver's License or ID.

LEVEL 2: On-Site Volunteers (frequent student interaction)

Examples of LEVEL 2 Volunteer support: Bus chaperone, helping at an all-day event (parade and field competition), and escorting students to the restroom.

- a. Completed volunteer application each school year.
- Provide a copy of your current
 California Driver's License or ID.
- c. Provide a negative TB skin test (good for 4 years).

LEVEL 3: Coaches and Chaperones who supervise students for Frequent Activities and Overnight Events

Examples of LEVEL 3 Volunteer support: DC Trip or other overnight events.

- a. Completed volunteer application each school year.
- Provide a copy of your current
 California Driver's License or ID.
- c. Provide a negative TB skin test (good for 4 years).
- d. Must be over 21 years of age.
- e. Fingerprint and County Livescan (fees apply).

Parent Booster Volunteer Needs

Uniforms and Grooming:

- Help students with uniforms such as attaching sash, tartan, glengarry, belt, etc.
- Provide grooming assistance braiding and pinning hair

Chuckwagon:

Provide and coordinate meals, snacks, and drinks to students & staff during marching band season at all competitions (Street and Field).

Seat Covers:

Place and later remove cloth seat coverings on bleachers in designated sections at home football games, awards and after field competitions.

Water Person(s):

Filling water jugs and squeeze bottles with water and ice. Water is needed at street and field competitions, for students when they must stand in place - water is brought to them in squeeze bottles. At football games, water is needed at the practice field area, the track where Guard rehearses, and in the stands. During competitions, water Is needed at base camp, and for parades, pulled behind the Band in one or more carts.

Truck Driver(s):

Brings instruments and equipment to performances, requires a volunteer form and an additional truck driver form clearance from GUSD. Generally, requires ownership of a truck, submission of driver's license and proof of insurance, and experience pulling a box trailer. Use of their own truck would be used to pull box trailers.

Street Practice Volunteers:

- For parade street practices near GHS, volunteers are needed to help monitor the intersections and hold flags and traffic signs to guide vehicles to detours around the band practice.
- Volunteers needed to set up and monitor plastic street barricades at intersections so students can practice on the street for parade competitions. This requires at least one person with an SUV or truck that can load and unload the plastic barricades.
